TDNC Program:

Activities include games in the woods and fields, swimming, Predator & Prey, The Amazing Race, Mystery Animal, tracking, hiking, exploring, arts & crafts, songs, campfires, shelter building, meet animals from the visiting Animal Adventures program & more. Campers must be entering the 1st-8th grade.

TDNC ECO ADVENTURES Older Campers Program:

Activities include kayaking with Still River Outfitters, rock climbing at Central Rock Climbing Gym with harnesses & ropes, an overnight sleeping in the big tent, raft building competition, team building activities, a conservation project & more. This program is for campers who are entering middle school (grades 6th-8th). Campers this age may choose this program or the TDNC program.

TDNC Counselor in Training Program:

Counselors in Training must be entering 9th or 10th grade. CITs must attend a mandatory 3 day Orientation (7/5-7) and work a minimum of 2 weeks. CITs gain valuable work experience and have fun.
